WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP

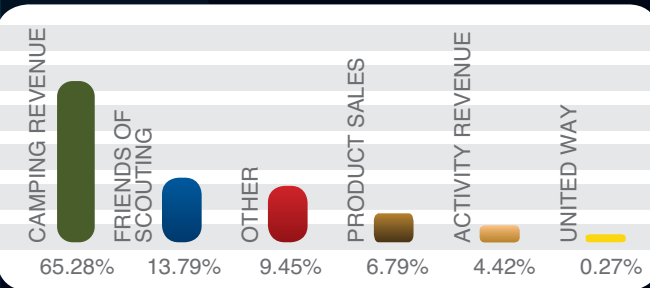

GIFT MATCHING

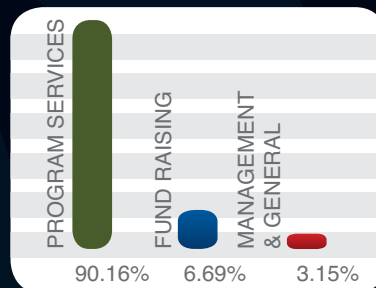
