## OPERATION SNOWSHOE 2021

This is a winter camping event for Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts for every unit large or small, experienced, or inexperienced. It is a patrol-oriented event, meant to develop and test scout skills. Patrols will camp and participate under the leadership of their own patrol leaders. Our objective is to provide a meaningful and challenging learning experience for all Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts. We also want it to be a safe and enjoyable event for all.

Some things to consider:

Due to COVID restrictions, everyone will need to **be prepared to sleep in tents** or shelters they bring with them. No cabins, Adirondacks, or pavilions at Camp Daniel Boone will be available to sleep in for this event. Please do not let this deter you from attending Operation Snowshoe. Why not get a tent for Christmas and enjoy your own back yard? Ozark Trail tents from Walmart are quality products and are as low as \$25.00 for a three or four-person tent.

Make sure you have **medical forms** for all participants, youth and adult.

Encourage all parents and adults in your unit to take **Youth Protection training**, print the certificate, and provide you with a copy. The information in the training is pertinent for Scouting but crosses over to leaders of any youth organization such as church groups or youth sports leagues.

**Field events** will include parts of First Responder; Into the Woods; Camper; Castaway; and Building a Better World. There may also be some elements of the Scout and Tenderfoot Scout badges. Remember Operation Snowshoe is a learning / teaching experience so do not become preoccupied with preparing your scouts for all events.

We do not know how the **pandemic** will affect us this winter but we are going ahead with planning and registering for this event. The staff is committed to making this a great event with safety foremost in our planning. Please do not hesitate to contact us with questions or concerns.
