MEMBERSHIP:

Over 1,200 young men and women participated in the programs of the Daniel Boone Council.

- Cub Scouts: 750 boys and girls
- Scouts BSA: 493 young men and women

Since 1920, over 4,550 young men and women in Western North Carolina have earned the rank of Eagle Scout.
